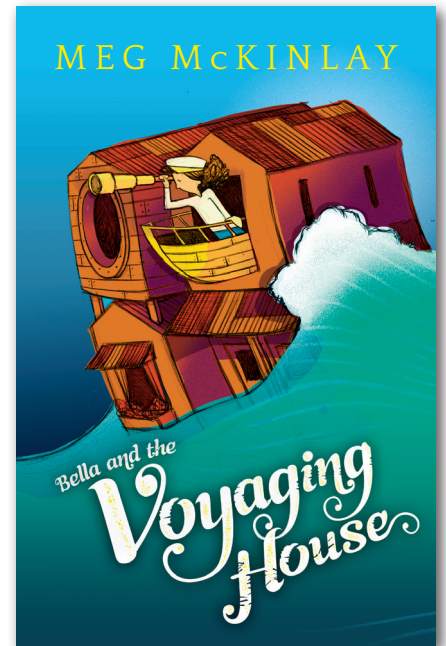





KEY POINTS
